- Increase A-E data for mathematics:
 - A & B data for mathematics in Semester One 2022 will be:
 - Prep- 51% Yr 1- 86% Yr 2- 82% Yr 3- 89% Yr 4- 89% Yr 5- 76% Yr 6- 80%
 - C or above achievement standard for mathematics in Semester One 2022- 96%
 - 100% of students demonstrating improvement in Learning Outcomes in the AC learning areas of English and Maths and the general capability – Personal and Social Capability.
- NAPLAN targets for mathematics:
 - Year 3 2022 – 65% in U2B in Numeracy.
 - Year 5 2022 – 65% in U2B in Numeracy.
 - NAPLAN targets in mathematics will be similar to or above like schools.
